This year's conference will celebrate MLAW's 25 years as a non-partisan, independent voice for Maryland Women and Families. A highlight of the conference will be a one-on-one conversation with Speaker of the Maryland House of Delegates, Adrienne A. Jones. Speaker Jones is the first African-American and the first woman to serve in this position in Maryland. After lunch, advocates and legislators will present proposals for the initiatives they will be supporting in the upcoming 2020 legislative session. After hearing about the proposed legislation, learn how you can make in impact in Annapolis! Our Grassroots Advocacy 101 workshop will cover the basics of how a bill becomes a law in Maryland, how to lobby for legislation as a grassroots activist, and learn the ins and outs of the legislative process. This is a full day conference and lunch will be provided to all participants.
